

# The “Not Quite Newlywed” Game

## *Directions:*

- We need a Quizmaster, a time-keeper, a score-keeper, pencils and 4 pieces of paper for each participant. We also need a 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize.
- Seat couples so they cannot see what the other writes.
- Ladies are asked the questions below.
- They are given 33 seconds after each question to write their answers.
- We then ask the men the *response questions*.
- *The men simply speak out their answers.*
- *The ladies hold up their answer paper for all to see.*
- *Each couple gets one point for each correct answer.*
- *Now switch roles. Ask Questions to the men, and the ladies respond.*
- *Add up points to see which couple is the winner. If there is a tie, ask the non-winner couples to suggest a tie-breaker question.*
- *Award the first and second prizes.*

## Questions to the Ladies:

1. How many children does your future husband want?
2. You have decided to buy a new entertainment system. Does your husband want to: A) wait until you save up the money. B) charge it on your credit card?
3. Both your families traditionally spend Christmas day together. Will your husband: A) insist you spend Christmas day with his family. B) agree to spend Christmas with your family. C) try to find a compromise?
4. In fighting, does he think he is: A) confrontational. B) the silent type?
5. What one change does your future husband expect of you after marriage?

## Men's Responses:

1. How many children do you want?
2. You and your wife have decided to buy a new entertainment system. Do you want to: A) wait until you save up the money. B) charge it on your credit card?
3. Both your families traditionally spend Christmas day together. Will you: A) insist on spending Christmas day with your family. B)

- agree to spend Christmas day with her family, C) Try to compromise?
4. In fighting, do you think you are: A) confrontational. B) the silent type?
  5. What one change do you expect in your fiancé after marriage?

Questions to the Men:

1. How often do you suppose your fiancé says you argue? (A) hardly ever (B) occasionally (C) daily
2. How often does she say you will go to Church together?
3. How often does your fiancé think it's OK for you to go out with your buddies? (A) The same as before (B) more than now (C) less than now (D) never
4. What three (3) chores do you expect your spouse to do once you are married?
5. What one change do you expect of your future wife after you are married?

Ladies' Response :

1. How often do you and your fiancé argue? (A) hardly ever (B) occasionally (C) daily
2. How often do you expect to go to Church together after marriage?
3. How often do you think it's OK for your husband to go out with his buddies?
4. What three chores will he expect you to do after you are married?
5. What one change will he expect of you after you are married?
